

**Statement On behalf of Keyingham Parish Council and Trustees of Boyes Lane Recreation Ground.
No 3.**

In response to further requests for information relating to a Charity Fundraising event for Great Ormond Street Hospital, Children's Cancer Charity, Charity Number 298405, which is planned to take place on in Keyingham on 7th August, please note:

Although the Parish Council is not the event organiser it has taken reasonable steps to ensure that the residents leading the event have obtained the relevant insurances and assessments for the activities advertised.

The organisers have shared documentation with the PC and following a review of the documents the Council is reasonably satisfied that they are appropriate and sufficient for the activities advertised. The documents remain the property of the organisers.

ERYC Licencing Team confirm that there is a **Temporary Event Notice** in place that covers the whole of Boyes Lane Recreation Field for 7th August, and that a premises licence is not required as the audience does not exceed 499 people. The Temporary Event Notice covers the sale of alcohol.

As the event is ticketed there is no requirement for food caterers to obtain street trading consent or for the organisers to obtain a collector's licence for any fundraising that takes place on the day.

Following discussions with the ERYC Licencing Team the Parish Council confirm that the event will take place provided that the following conditions are adhered to:

The event will take place between 11.00 am and 11.00pm on the 7thAugust. * The organisers have confirmed that music will conclude by 9.00pm.

There will be no overnight camping on Council Land.

There will be no use of, or access to, the buildings which are subject to a retrospective planning application and will be cordoned off.

Independent drinking water supplies and accessible toilets will be provided.

Each individual attending this ticketed, open-air event is responsible for ensuring that they adhere to precautionary measures to help reduce the spread of Covid 19.

The NHS Covid Poster will be displayed at the entry to the event.
