

THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)****TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC****Chapel Lane, Keyingham**

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Chapel Lane, Keyingham commencing Monday 12th January 2026 (between 08:00 hrs and 20:00 hrs) to install a new water supply connection.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16 January 2026.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via the remainder of Chapel Lane, Main Street, Ings Lane and Clay Lane, Keyingham.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. Access will be maintained for pedestrians, residents access and the emergency services only.
