

THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC EASTFIELD ROAD, KEYINGHAM (PART)

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Eastfield Road, Keyingham (**BETWEEN** the junctions of Waudby Garth Road, Keyingham **AND** Main Street/Ottringham Road, Keyingham) commencing **2 December 2024** to allow carriageway maintenance works to be carried out by East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public.

The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within the same day.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via Main Street, Station Road and Waudby Garth Road, Keyingham.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but **access will** be maintained for residents, the emergency services and pedestrians.
